CODE REFERENCE: 64E-11.003(4). Equipment and utensils must be properly designed, constructed, and in good repair.</p> |
| <p>Violation #54. Garbage & refuse disposal Observed missing drain plug at garbage dumpster. Provide drain plug. CODE REFERENCE: 64E-11.003(5). Garbage shall be disposed of to prevent vector harborage. Trash cans will be durable, cleanable, leak proof, insect and rodent resistant, and non-absorbent. Outside storage area shall be of a smooth, non-absorbent material and sloped to a drain.</p> |
